COVID situation in Kolkata is improving and this week vaccination has started on priority basis.

People are bit more relaxed, public places, business etc open, only School and regular lessons are not yet permitted. We hope in February lesson, classes will start. In our IIMC Project, we are open in all programmes. Monday and Thursday outdoor clinic in our Tegharia Campus – Dhaki and Chakberia open as well and indoor patients mothers and children rehabilitation centers are in regular services.

Barnali and her education team with all Teachers are organizing Schools & sponsoring children. New academic Year's admission process going on with distribution of New books, Pen, Pencils etc. and taking care all sponsored students for their daily need.

Mothers economical programme mostly in deep rural areas in regular and good function because COVID is not a rural problem - around 26000 mothers are members of this programme and running small business and enterprises with IIMC Microcredit programme in several villages.

Women Peace Council - around 700 rural mothers in 70 different villages are learning their basic right and empowering socially, culturally and intellectually, one of our best project to empower our rural mothers. These mothers supporting many local families with Cow Project and Old age Care and Child education programme.

IIMC Network Health and Education Project covers - 45 different areas with Primary Health Care and Kinder Garden Education, which is in operation with the help of 150 primary health workers.

IIMC Residential Shelter home – Children are always with us even during Locked Down they could not move as most of them have no parents or home.

During whole period of COVID problem, Locked Down, Amphan Cyclone- IIMC volunteers remain active in frontline without stopping a single day, we did every week food distribution, Essential Supply, Medical Camps and Socio Psychological support. During this difficult period you all were with us. All of you continuously giving necessary support and inspiration.

We all are hoping situation will completely improve and we shall meet each other soon.

2021 will give us back our normal life and soon we shall receive international volunteers to join with us.

The Good news is as IIMC Volunteers were always in frontline, Government has given us priority to receive Vaccine free of cost.
